Our May paycheck will be second of two paychecks with no health premium deduction. Members will see their health premium deduction resume in their June paycheck. If you are on the twelve-paycheck cycle, there will be no deductions in your July and August paychecks.

#### What is the best plan for me and my family?

Over the course of the four meetings, there was much discussion regarding Plan C premiums. It became apparent to many that Plan C no longer may be the best fit for themselves and/or their family. A member put together a cost sheet highlighting the discussion and compared premium rates with max out of pocket liabilities and found plan F to be more cost effective than plan C in several instances. (Attached.)

Since every PEHT participant and family has different health care needs, I thought I would attach the member's work for you to review. With approximately 60% of AEA PEHT participants enrolled in Plan C, it may be a good time to evaluate your health care needs, costs, and make any plan adjustments you feel benefit your situation. The attachment does not include comparisons with the newly offered HDHP Plan.

Some members will ask, how do I know which Plan is best for me? AEA and PEHT suggest you speak to an advisor, accountant, etc. AEA and PEHT cannot say which plan is best for your needs. I personally look at my premium rates, max out of pocket liabilities, and estimate my family needs based on past experience. For my family, a move to Plan F two years ago seemed a better fit. Again, if you are not sure, please contact an advisor.

#### PEHT Open enrollment ends 5pm on June 17, 2022.

During open enrollment members may:

- Decline (waive) coverage (with proof of other coverage) OR
- Select coverage if previously waived **OR**
- Change your plan selection (C, F, or HDHP) **AND/OR** level of coverage (tier) which best meets your (family's) needs.
