SALARY, ADDENDA, & COVERAGE PAY

- A) Please take a moment and double check your Salary Placement Statement located in District Connection, home.asdk12.org. Double check you are in the correct cell, correct lane, and have your Masters / Doctorate supplement added in correctly.
 - If you have any questions, please contact your Talent Management Team using *this document*. If you need support, please reach out to Courtney, Val, or myself.
- B) Many educators have the opportunity to earn addenda. Just like your Salary Statement Placement is your contract for your teaching assignment, addenda positions represent additional contracts outlining the job/task and the amount of pay. Please sign your addenda contracts before the activity or task begins so there is no misunderstanding and/or confusion on what the job is and how much you will be paid. The first paragraph in Article 150 states: "Contract addenda will be signed prior to the beginning of the activity, except by mutual agreement. In no case shall more than thirty days pass from the onset of activity before the acceptance of the addendum and completion of the necessary addenda form."
- C) Coverage pay will be given to those who are asked to cover a class during your instructional planning time. Clearly communicate with your supervisor on the amount of your coverage.

Coverage pay during your instructional planning time follows these general principles:

- 1) If you are covering another class or your own class and you still have additional duties to complete, you should be compensated.
- 2) If you are reassigned to cover another class and you have no additional duties, you would not receive compensation.

Moreover, if you miss any of your 30 minute duty free lunch due to a request from your principal, you are entitled to compensation at your per diem rate. As much as possible get the request from your principal in writing so there are no misunderstandings.

Details on Coverage Pay are highlighted in <u>Article 470</u>. <u>Use this form</u> when submitting for coverage pay. You have 10 days to submit your form from the day you provided coverage.
